



2010 UGV PHOTO COMPETITION Call for Participation



PARTICIPANTS

This competition is open to organisations and persons in the following categories:

- UGV system and sub-system manufacturers;
- Organizations (both private & public) carrying out research and development activities on a commercial or non-commercial basis;
- Organizations (both private & public) supplying services with or for UAS on a commercial or non-commercial basis;
- Military organizations;
- Private individuals (civil & military).

PHOTO CATEGORIES

Photos in the following categories can be submitted:

- 0a** UGV - Static (studio, or in situ)
 - 0b** UGV - Conceptual (drawing, painting, computer generated)
 - 0c** UGV - Fully functional prototype
 - 01** Sensor (imaging & non-Imaging; separate or mounted on a UGV)
 - 02** Manipulator (separate, or mounted on a UGV)
 - 03** Armament (separate, or mounted on a UGV)
 - 04** Control Station
 - 05** Transport & Handling & Storage
 - 06** Maintenance & Repair
 - 07** System overview showing complete UGV system [vehicle, control station, payloads (vehicle-mounted and/or unmounted), with or without personnel]
 - 08** Operational deployment (situational photo)
 - 09** Transmitted imagery
- Unmanned ground vehicle (UGV) systems = governmental (non-military), commercial, military & research (all sizes & classes, incl. autonomous, programmable, wire-guided, wireless remote controlled).

SUBMISSION

A company or photographer can submit several photos in several categories. All photos supplied should be free of any logos, company names and legends on the photo.

Photos are to be supplied to Blyenburgh & Co electronically. In addition, hardcopy photographic prints may be supplied.

Electronic Photos - Submission & Designation

All electronic photos should have a size of **15x10 cm**, a resolution of at least **300 dpi**, should be supplied in **JPEG format**. Submissions can be uploaded to the Blyenburgh & Co FTP portal, supplied on CD, posted on a FTP port for downloading by Blyenburgh & Co, or emailed to Blyenburgh & Co.

The electronic photo file names should be constructed as follows: 2-digit reference number of the photo category for which the submission is made (see above), abbreviated name of photographer (if applicable)(dash between first & family name), manufacturer & country of origin & product designation & reference number, separated by underscores (e.g. **03_n-smith_modtech_luxembourg_tracer_04**)

An Excel form with 5 columns, indicating the following information for each photo, should also be supplied:

- 2-digit ref.nr. of applicable photo category (see above);
- complete name of the photographer (if applicable);
- name of organization submitting photo (if applicable);
- designation of the UGV or relevant product;
- photo reference number (if more than 1 photo is submitted in the same category).

This Excel form should also indicate the complete postal address + tel & fax numbers + email address of the point of contact with the submitting organization.

Hardcopy Photos (Optional)

Hardcopy prints should measure 100x150 mm, or larger, and have a label on their backside indicating: 2-digit number of the photo category for which the submission is made, name of the submitting company and/or photographer + postal address, tel & fax number & email address. The hardcopy prints supplied will not be returned.

COPYRIGHT

All photos submitted should be free of copyright. If the submitted photos have been previously published, a signed statement must be supplied by the submitting entity that no copyrights will be infringed by the use of such photos by Blyenburgh & Co. Blyenburgh & Co shall have the right to publish any photo submitted for the contest in any printed, on-line, digital or electronic publication.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

All photos should be received prior to **10 April 2010**. FTP addresses from which photos can be downloaded should be active and notified to Blyenburgh & Co prior to **3 April 2010**.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

- In the 2010 UGV Yearbook (the first copies will be made available to the delegates at the UGV 2010 conference);
- Collectively on special award posters which will be exhibited at the UGV 2010 conference;
- As individually files & made available to the international press for downloading from www.uvs-info.com (13 June 2010);
- Collectively on an electronic poster, which will be made available for free downloading & printing on www.uvs-info.com (13 June 2010);
- Collectively as a printable electronic poster which will be included on the CD with UGV 2010 conference proceedings.
